

	Build-Out Line Refresher	<p>There are a couple of things that will be added to the rules of play:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -OFFSIDES: HALFWAY LINE (not build-out line) -Build-out line becomes active as soon as keeper touches the ball. If keeper plays ball immediately, the ball is live. If keeper holds on to ball, offense must retreat. Keeper may dribble ball, roll it to teammate behind buildout line or pass to teammate behind buildout line. The offensive players may not cross the buildout line until the 1st defensive player has touched the ball. Keeper may not do a fast restart unless it is kicked to teammate behind the buildout line. Keeper may throw the ball beyond the build out line. Mike Sroka will put this in writing and shall send a copy to all coaches on U9-U10 and referee assigners. Keeper may request offensive players to retreat by holding the ball. If keeper dribbles ball, they must still pass to teammate behind build-out line. There are NO goal kicks allowed. Keeper should only kick the ball to a teammate within the build-out line. -Build-Out Line applies to Goal kicks. -Direct and Indirect inside the 18-yard line, build-out line rule applies. -Direct or indirect kick outside the 18-yard line, build-out-line rule does NOT apply. -Build-Out line is there to promote young players learning how to play from the back. <p>IF any clubs have video of U9/U10 games showing buildout line play, pls email to Mike Sroka.</p>

Penalty?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Rule states each team must receive opposing team's roster and you must have a printed roster to hand in with the game report. -No penalty if an extra roster is not provided. -One roster is needed for the game to start. -Opposing team must be allowed to see the roster. Picture may be taken.
	Playing Time Rule	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> U12 Younger: Practice 80% play minimum 50% play time. This is PER GAME and NOT an aggregate for the season! -U9-U10 – rule remains unchanged. -U11-U12 – Division 1 ONLY - should this rule be removed? Consensus is NO. Rule remains unchanged U12 and Under regardless of division.
